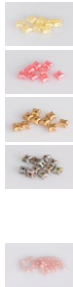

# Orion's Belt

Try out this relatively simple tutorial on how to make a fashion accessory using the small PRECIOSA Orion Pressed Beads and PRECIOSA Rocailles. You can make an attractive bracelet or an entire jewelry set.

## Materials and tools:

- PRECIOSA Orion (O)  
111 01 379; 3 x 5 mm;  
02010/25039; yellow; 2x 20
- 02010/25007; pink; 2x 20
- 02010/01710; gold; 2x 20
- 02010/65431; grey; 2x 20
- PRECIOSA Rocailles (R)  
331 19 001; 10/0;  
Solgel 02213; skin-tone 344x



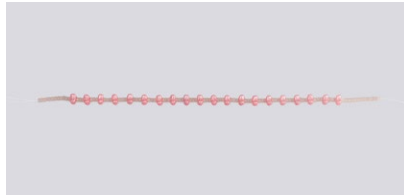
caps, eye pins, a small carabiner, an adjusting chain, linking rings, needle-nose pliers, snipping pliers, scissors, a ruler, a stringing needle, a thread

## Procedure:

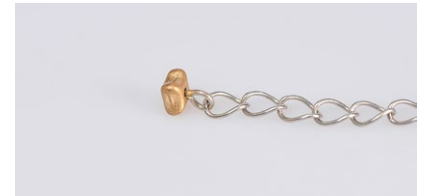
**Step 1:**  
String 12x R; then alternately string 1x O and 3x R; repeat this 18x. Then string 1x O and 12x R. This will give you the stringing for a standard bracelet: 17 cm long. You can adjust the length as needed. Cut off the thread so that 10 cm of empty thread remains on both sides. Repeat this stringing 7 more times. Use the color combination of your choice.



**Step 2:**  
Place the strung threads together and tie them off with a knot at both ends. Use the second knot to tighten the strung beads and seed beads. Pull an eye pin under the knot, thread the end of the pin through its eye and use the pliers to tighten it well. String a cap and 1x O on the end of the pin and create a loop. Repeat the procedure on the other end of the stringing.



**Step 3:**  
Connect the carabiner with a connecting ring and the adjusting chain in the other end of the stringing. Attach 1x O to the chain.



**Step 4:**  
You can also create a necklace from a longer stringing or earrings from a shorter one.
